Re-opening of Anse Mondon trail

The Anse Mondon trail located in the enchanting nature reserve in the northeastern part of Silhouette island officially re-opened on Sunday September 30 following restoration by the Islands Development Company (IDC), the Island Conservation Society (ICS) and team members of Hilton Labriz Resort & Spa.
